### Medical Study Recruitment

The Renaissance Study examines a new medication designed to improve the treatment of MDD. This is the first medication in 40 years to utilize a new mechanism of action in treating depression (neuronal nicotine antagonist). In previous research trials, treatment with this medication combined with a standard antidepressant showed significantly higher rates of remission than the standard antidepressant alone.

We are actively recruiting two groups of patients for this study: patients who are currently taking antidepressants **and still having depressive symptoms** and those who are not **now taking antidepressants**. Referred patients who are not presently on an anti-depressant will receive one of the eight commonly prescribed antidepressant medications (SSRI or SNRI) as part of this study. Those who do not achieve remission on this medication will then be randomized into the study medication phase of the trial. Patients who are already taking one of the approved antidepressant medications will continue their medication and be given study medication.
